Its design also allows it to interface with electronic health record (EHR) and electronic medical record (EMR) systems that may already be in use at your facility.

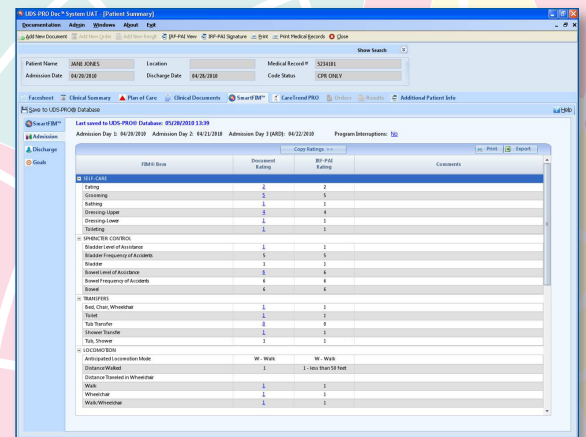
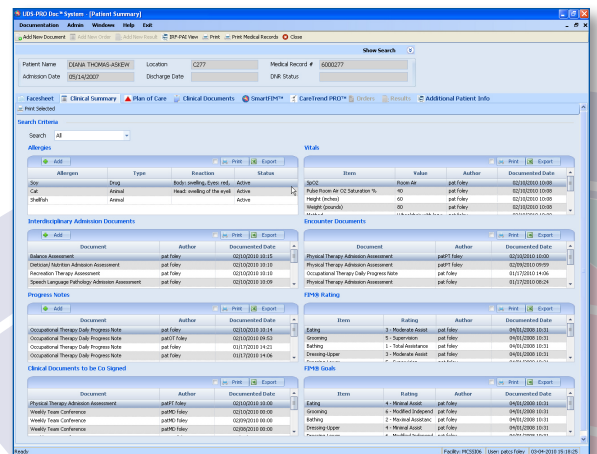

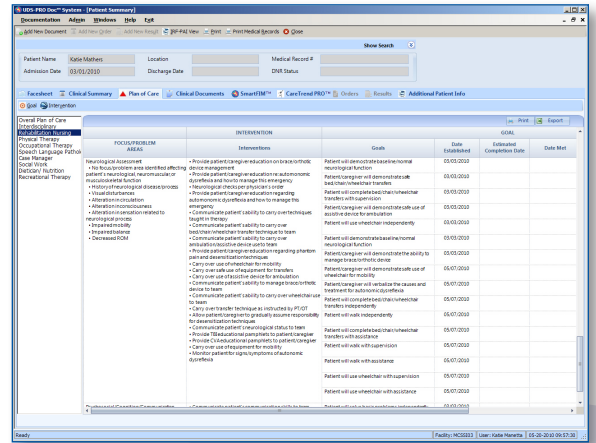
