- Conducting IRF PPS coding audits

 - CPC credential from the AAPC
- At least two years of experience in medical coding
- Strong analytical skills
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to produce detailed, comprehensive documentation and reports

- Experience in IRF coding
- Experience in rehab coding
